PHOENIX, ARIZ. — Legal Assistance and Law Related Education will be offered to thousands of Arizonan's next year with the help of over \$1,300,000 in 2007 grant awards announced by the Arizona Foundation for Legal Services & Education (The Foundation).

"The Foundation Board is honored to assist in the efforts of these excellent organizations," said David Haga, 2006 Foundation Board President. "In addition to the traditional Interest on Lawyer Trust Accounts (IOLTA) grant awards, the Foundation is able to distribute additional grants totaling \$175,000 as a result of the generous support of the State Bar of Arizona's members."

Dr. Kevin S. Ruegg, Executive Director of the Foundation, reports that with these funds the Foundation anticipates over 18,000 families will receive free legal assistance and several thousands of children will be able to participate in civics programs to prepare them for the office of citizen. Ruegg said, "The grantees are providing much needed help to many and while I know they appreciate the Foundation's support, the need is even greater. With that understanding, the Foundation welcomes partners in promoting access to justice. Supporting legal services and law-related education is an investment in the very fabric of our country's justice system.
